Bullet Safaris operates in multiple countries to provide our clients with new experiences and a variety of species. From a family hunting vacation to a quest for a trophy lion or elephant, we can outfit and guide you on the adventure of a lifetime. Our customized photographic and touring safaris are available throughout Africa.



South Africa: Best known for its great plains game hunting. The private properties and lodge type atmosphere is conducive to both serious hunters and vacationing families. Plains game safaris are affordable and South Africa has many species available for hunting. It is not uncommon for a first time safari hunter to shoot ten species on a safari. The ease of logistics and modern day conveniences make South Africa a prime destination for many first time safari hunters and experienced African sportsmen alike.

Tanzania: This is the premier destination for wilderness hunting adventures. We hunt remote concessions teeming with wildlife and uninfluenced by man in many places. Our concessions in the Rungwa district are among the best hunting areas on the continent. The Selous Game Reserve in Tanzania is the largest uninhabited wilderness left in Africa and we can take you hunting there. We have specialized areas for big elephant and some of the best lion and leopard hunting in Africa. Tanzania is prime territory for a full bag safari (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and plains game).

Zimbabwe: Despite the recent economic troubles this country has experienced, the safari and hunting industries have continued to deliver great experiences to our overseas visitors. It is home to Victoria Falls and is still a good country for dangerous game safari. You can hunt many species here including lion, elephant, leopard, and buffalo. Crocodile and hippo are available in good numbers.

Mozambique: Historically this country was one of the best hunting destinations in Africa. A long civil war and poaching brought this beautiful land to its knees, rendering it one of the poorest countries in the world. Mozambique and its game populations have recovered mainly due to the efforts of sportsmen like you. Mozambique is not for the first time hunter as the conditions and hunting here are difficult. Many areas are large with low animal density. Mozambique offers buffalo hunts in the swamps, large leopard roaming the interior, along with great crocodile and hippo to be hunted on the Zambezi River.

Zambia: This country offers excellent hunting of dangerous game. Zambia's famous Luangwa Valley, Kafue National Park, and the wetland areas of the north host rich hunting grounds for our clients' safaris. The varied habitats support a broad range of species including lion, leopard, buffalo, hippo, crocodile, plus numerous plains game species unique to Zambia.

Botswana: Great camps and good logistics make Botswana a pleasurable hunt for one of the greatest African trophies – The African Elephant. Other animals available on quota are very limited, but include buffalo and plains game. We frequently combine these elephant hunts with plains game hunting in an adjoining country.

Other Countries: We offer safaris in Cameroon, the Central African Republic, and Ethiopia. These safaris are for Bongo, Lord Derby Eland, Forest Buffalo, Mountain Nyala, and specialized plains game.



Every country has different rules and regulations for the hunting and touring industries. It is important to discuss the goals of your safari with us as well as other personal constraints so we can place you on the right safari. Your efforts support the local people in each area and all of the animals hunted are utilized to the fullest extent. Hunting in Africa is an effective management tool and a true form of conservation. Many of the areas and animal populations we currently hunt would not be in existence without the support of hunters. Lion: Only a select few will experience a lion hunt in the wild. To see a paw print in the sand the size of your face brings even the most accomplished hunter down to earth – to hear a lion roar arouses a primeval fear that few will ever know. Hunting a lion on his terms is one of the greatest challenges in Africa.



Buffalo: The toughest animal on earth. At times, Cape Buffalo seem impervious to even the heaviest calibers and the best placed shots. Hunting these animals is an active pursuit on foot followed by selecting and stalking a single trophy. Be ready and be accurate when your shot presents itself – your life may depend on it.



Elephant: An action packed hunt from start to finish. Hunting these huge animals in the thick bush of Africa is not for the faint of heart. Wild elephants are not fond of humans, and standing down a charging elephant is not everyone's idea of a great trip. Correct shot placement and equipment will aid you in effectively hunting these animals.



Hippo: Semi-aquatic, big, and fast when they need to be - Hippo hunting will put you face to face with this giant. Encounters take place in thick riverine bush to open flood plains to the river itself. This is an amphibious adventure and a unique hunting experience. Watch out for crocs and carry enough gun as these animals frequently charge.





Leopard: Possibly the most beautiful and difficult trophy to take is an old male leopard. This secretive predator is fast, strong and cunning. They are acutely aware of their surroundings and extremely dangerous when wounded. Years of experience and months of preparation go into every leopard hunt.



Plains Game: The various antelope species in Africa are fun to hunt and are found across the continent. Some species are widely distributed while others are very habitat specific. A plains game hunt is the most affordable safari and a great experience in Africa. A few of the more popular species are pictured here (Above: Kudu and Gemsbok Below: Giraffe, Warthog, Nyala, Niassa Wildebeest, Hyena, Red Lechwe, Impala, Zebra, and Waterbuck).



Crocodile: Individual crocodiles can be close to 100 years old. They can smell as good as any antelope and can feel vibrations from an approaching person through the ground and water; crocs also listen to the alarm calls of shore birds and retreat accordingly. Their ancient but effective design makes croc hunting a challenging sport.

These safaris are usually geared towards hunting dangerous game in large government concessions. We will assist in handle all aspects of your safari. At Bullet Safaris we don't take a cut of your payment and send you down the line to hunt with another operator or professional hunter. Nathan Askew is still very active as a professional hunter, guiding most of the dangerous game hunts as well as a large portion of the plains game safaris. Nathan Askew and his staff are licensed professional hunters with the experience to guide you on the hunt of a lifetime and have the expertise to handle any situation.

Booking Your Safari

Safari Equipment

Clothing – 3 trousers or jeans (dark khaki or green), shorts, 3 shirts (cotton, long and short sleeve depending on time of year), t-shirts, coat or down jacket, hat of your choice, socks, underwear, belt, pair of leather boots (uninsulated, hiking), leather gloves, sandals, and a dark colored sweater or fleece. All outer clothing should be dark brown or green.

Miscellaneous – knife, chapstick, sunscreen, sunglasses, range finder, GPS, binoculars, camera/video equip., medications, personal travel kit (razor, toothbrush, etc), flashlight with extra batteries, extra contacts/glasses (if required), wet wipes, duct tape, Ziploc bags, trophy tags from your taxidermist, 2 belt type shell holders, rifle sling, and a thin soft gun case.

Other – travel documents, passport, reading material, airline tickets, cash and credit card. Normal voltage supply in Africa is 220 volts-50 cycles and the plugs are country specific.

Weapon – African game are notorious for being tough. Most situations call for a rifle in the .30 caliber range with an appropriate scope and zeroed at 100-150 yards. A large caliber rifle is required for dangerous game. A 375 H&H Mag, 458 Lott, 416 Rigby, or 470 N.E. with a detachable, variable power scope is excellent for most situations.

Archery hunting is available.

Ammunition – All hunts will require high quality expanding bullets such as a Swift A-frame or a Barnes X. Solid bullets will be needed for dangerous game.
